ORDER MODIFYING PORTIONS OF SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND ORDER

ORDER

On June 28, 2011, the Nevada State Board of Osteopathic Medicine (the Board) affirmed and entered its Settlement Agreement and Order in this matter. On August 13, 2013 the Board heard a presentation from Dr. Chen's practice monitor, Dr. Daniel Burkhead. Dr. Burkhead explained that Dr. Chen is generally compliant with the terms of the Settlement Agreement and Order and that in his opinion Dr. Chen is prepared to prescribe controlled substances without restriction as long as he continues to be monitored pursuant to and according to the remaining terms of the Settlement Agreement and Order. After questioning Dr. Burkhead and after due consideration and deliberation, the Board determined to amend its Settlement Agreement and Order in this matter as follows:

- 1. In order to mitigate the concerns raised by Dr. Chen regarding his payment of the amounts due pursuant to paragraph 2 of the Stipulated Adjudication section of the Settlement Agreement and Order, for all payments made by Dr. Chen for the dates between June 11, 2013 and December 31, 2013, the Board will credit an equal amount from the total payment due.
- 2. Pursuant to paragraph 4(e) of the Stipulated Adjudication section of the Settlement Agreement and Order, the Board hereby orders that Dr. Chen may prescribe whatever controlled substance or controlled substances for a patient to treat any condition he diagnoses for the patient, including but not limited to the treatment of acute or chronic pain, subject to the other terms and conditions of the Settlement Agreement and Order. Dr. Burkhead and the Board's staff shall continue to monitor Dr. Chen's prescribing practices to assure compliance with the Settlement Agreement and Order and to assure that the prescribing is within the standard of care for the treatments of the conditions Dr. Chen seeks to treat.

3. All other terms and conditions in the Settlement Agreement and Order not modified in this order shall remain in full force and effect.
