10	The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing,
11	regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians, in the state of
12	Oregon. Vincent Edward Hansen, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the state of Oregon

14	The Board received credible information regarding Licensee that resulted in the Board
15	initiating an investigation. The results of the Board's investigation to date have raised concerns
16	to the extent that the Board believes it necessary that Licensee agree to cease the practice of
17	medicine until the investigation is completed.

19	In order to address the concerns of the Board, Licensee and the Board agree to enter into
20	this Interim Stipulated Order, which provides that Licensee shall comply with the following
21	conditions effective the date this Order is signed by Licensee:
22	3.1 Licensee voluntarily withdraws from the practice of medicine and his license is
23	placed in Inactive status pending the completion of the Board's investigation into his ability to
24	safely and competently practice medicine.
25	3.2 Licensee understands that violating any term of this Order will be grounds for
26.	disciplinary action under ORS 677.190(17).

9	The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing,
0	regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including osteopathic physicians, in the
1	state of Oregon. Danijela Mozina Marjanovic, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the state
2	of Oregon.
3	2.
4	Licensee is a family practice physician, practicing in Canyonville, Oregon. The Board
5	opened an investigation in September 2012 base upon credible evidence that Licensee had been
6	inappropriately prescribing opiates. Another investigation was opened in January of 2013
7	regarding Licensee's failure to produce medical records in a timely manner.
8	3.
19	Licensee and the Board agree to close this investigation with this Stipulated Order in
20	which Licensee agrees to retire her license while under investigation, consistent with the terms of
21	this Order. Licensee understands that she has the right to a contested case hearing under the
22	Administrative Procedures Act (chapter 183), Oregon Revised Statutes and fully and finally
23	waives the right to a contested case hearing and any appeal therefrom by the signing of and entry
24	of this Order in the Board's records. By entering into this Order, Licensee understands that
25	although the Board makes no finding at this time as to whether her conduct violated the Medical
26	Practice Act, this document is a public record and is reportable to the national DataBank and the
27	Federation of State Medical Boards.
