STATE BOARD OF MEDICINE TAKES DISCIPLINARY ACTION

WAKEFIELD: At its meeting Monday, the state Board of Registration in Medicine took disciplinary action against the medical license of Andrew Ting, M.D.

The Board accepted the resignation of Dr. Andrew Ting. Resignation is a disciplinary action that permanently removes a physician from practice. He had entered into a Voluntary Agreement Not to Practice with the Board in 2011. Dr. Ting is a 1996 graduate of Boston University School of Medicine. He is board certified in Family Medicine and has been licensed to practice medicine in Massachusetts since 1998. His practice was located in Hamilton.

The Massachusetts Board of Registration in Medicine licenses more than 40,000 physicians, osteopaths and acupuncturists. The Board was created in 1894 to protect the public health and safety by setting standards for the practice of medicine and ensuring that doctors who practice in the Commonwealth are appropriately qualified and competent.
