Abulhasan U. Ansari, M.D., License #: D24208

Area of Practice: Internal Medicine (Clinton, MD)

Reprimand; Fine of \$25,000; Probation for a minimum of three years with terms and conditions. The Board found that the physician failed to meet the standard of care, failed to keep adequate medical records, filed false reports in the practice of medicine, used unlicensed staff to obtain x-rays and to perform physical therapy and grossly overutilized health care services, in eight patients reviewed. Date of Action: May 24, 2012

Area of Practice: Emergency Medicine (Mountain Home, ID)

Letter of Surrender; No petition for Reinstatement for a period of five years. The physician decided to surrender his license to avoid further discipline. Date of Action: May 9, 2012

Reprimand, Probation for a minimum of 18 months with terms and conditions. The Board found that the physician engaged in unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine, failed to meet the standards of quality medical care and failed to keep adequate medical records. Area of Practice: Unspecified (Frederick, MD)
