**INTERIM REINSTATEMENT ORDER  
(Public)**

This matter came before the State Board of Medical Examiners ("Board") on August 6, 2013, pursuant to the request of the above named respondent ("Respondent") for reinstatement of his medical license, which had been temporarily suspended. Respondent appeared and testified at the August 6, 2013 hearing, and was represented by Jonathan P. Hammond, Esquire.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On November 16, 2011, the Board issued an Order of Temporarily Suspension of Respondent's medical license.
2. On December 5, 2011, the Board received Respondent's voluntary surrender of his state and federal privileges for prescribing controlled substances.
3. On March 15, 2012, the Board issued a public Interim Order of Reinstatement, reinstating Respondent's license subject to conditions stated in that interim order, pending a final order or further the order of the Board.
4. On September 20, 2012, the Board issued a second Order of Temporary Suspension of Respondent's medical license
5. On August 6, 2013, the Board heard Respondent's petition for reinstatement of his license and announced conditions, including but not limited to passing the SPEX exam, that would be placed on Respondent's practice.
6. Respondent took the SPEX examination on October 10, 2010, and on or about October 22, 2013, the Board was notified that Respondent had passed the examination.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**


The Board, in accordance with S.C. Code §§ 1-23-370(c) and 40-47-110(D)(1) of the 1976 issued an order of Temporary Suspension, dated September 12, 2012, with respect to Respondent. After reviewing the information provided to the Board to determine Respondent's fitness to practice

with a reasonable degree of skill and safety to the public, the Board concludes that it is the public interest to reinstate Respondent to the practice of medicine pending a Final Order of the Board at the conclusion of all pending charges, upon the limited and certain conditions, as specified below.

**THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT** Respondent's request for reinstatement of his medical license is GRANTED, pending a Final Order or further Order of the Board.
